

Patio Area and Pool Rules and Regulations

Per Governor Abbott's Executive Order No. GA-29, "Every person in Texas shall wear a face covering over the nose and mouth when...in an outdoor public space, wherever it is not feasible to maintain six feet of social distancing from another person not in the same household."

- A signed Windsor Hills Release and Indemnity Agreement, for each person intending to use this facility, must be on file at the Clubhouse prior to using the pool and patio area.
- Residents are asked to wear the wristbands issued by the Staff, resulting from submitting the Windsor Hills Release and Indemnity Agreement.
- The intent for the use of the pool is exercising, not social gathering.
- The area will be open from 6 AM to 12 AM, Tues. - Sun., and closed Mondays for cleaning.
- Until further notice, the maximum occupancy of this total area is 35 people with only 25 of the 35 in the pool at any one time.
- Maintain at least a six-foot distance from people who are not a part of your household, both in and out of the pool.
- Residents are requested to wear a mask while in the patio area but it is NOT recommended while in the pool.
- Open only to residents; **NO** guests, adults or children.
- Bring and take with you your own chairs and other needed furniture
- The bocce ball court will remain closed until further notice.
